## GAPSA General Assembly October 14, 2020

## **Meeting Notes**

- Welcome from Officers
- Attendance
- Guest Speaker: Dr. Laurence Bray
  - New funding opportunities:
    - Achievement Award (\$4000, about 3-6 credits)
      - Will be launching in about 2-3 weeks, for Spring 2021
      - A new one will launch in the Spring for Fall 2021
    - Dissertation Completion Assistantships (full time, part time, etc.)
      - Available now here:
        - https://provost.gmu.edu/academics-and-research/graduate-education/awa rds-and-grants
    - Both awards are competitive and TBD how many
  - Asking about racial-ethnicity on grant and scholarship applications
    - Multiple people expressed concerns over bias if they include that information
    - One suggestion is to ask the question after awards are made
    - Also important to create spaces for diversity of perspectives, especially on tough topics such as race and ethnicity
  - Question about use of the library during the pandemic
    - Dr. Kim reminds everyone that they can request books to be pulled and made available to students in a no-contact exchange
  - We are looking for 3 graduate students to get involved in the anti-racism task force (20 hours per week, paid student wage), starting as soon as possible
    - If anyone is interested, Dr. Bray can share the descriptions
- Discussion on Spring 2021 Schedule (and Spring Break)
  - Faculty Senate is voting today at 3p between early finish and late start

    - Many students are voicing frustration over not being aware of this until last minute (when it's too late to weigh in options)
      - Importance of Spring Break: time off, mental health, stress, etc. especially given the current circumstances
    - Concerns that have been heard from graduate students
      - Faculty aren't able to give students a week off (even if they'd like to) because it reduces instruction time to just 13 weeks
      - Early finish is nice due to longer summer (especially out of state students who would like to return home)

- At the same time, there are major concerns from PhD students who would be unable to finish their dissertations a week earlier (and thus would be unable to graduate)
- Also, unsure how this affects programs that run on an alternative module schedule (e.g., MBA program and law school)
  - This won't affect the 100% online asynchronous Wiley programs (e.g., MPS in Psychology) though
- Other options that are being suggested
  - Offer one week of classes with no due dates in lieu of Spring Break
  - Move Spring Break later in the semester, then go online for the rest of the semester
  - Do the "Patriot Days" option with 1-day breaks spread out
- VOTING RESULTS
  - 14 for early finish, 8 for late start
  - 15 for some "other" option: one assignment-free week, or later Spring Break and move online after, or "Patriot Days"
- One new concern: GAPSA needs to know about these important changes ahead of time
  - We should advocate to have an undergrad and grad student non-voting "observer" sit on the Faculty Senate
