 - Mike Meese, Vice Rector of George Mason University's Board of Visitors, provided an overview of the role and function of the BOV. He also addressed recent BOV decisions and discussions and responded to questions from representatives.

 - BOV Overview:
 - 16 members, each serving up to 8 years, with 4 new members appointed annually by the Governor.
 - Responsible for funding, tuition, budgets, faculty promotions, and university policies.
 - Concern about tuition and funding for international students expressed by program representative Recent BOV decisions: Institutional Neutrality & DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion):
 - o **DEI:** The BOV has **limited engagement** in DEI programming.
 - DEI: "Just Societies" undergraduate coursework is optional and not a university-wide requirement.
 - Institutional Neutrality: GMU maintains a neutral stance on sociopolitical matters while supporting diverse perspectives.
 - Concerns About Policy Changes & Graduate Student Impact:
 - GMU has navigated political shifts before and remains committed to supporting students.
 - Graduate students are encouraged to engage with GAPSA, attend BOV meetings, and use campus resources to voice concerns.

7. Student Concerns & Action Items

Addressing Policy Uncertainty:

- If students feel unsafe or uncertain, they can reach out to GAPSA for guidance.
- Attend BOV meetings to stay informed and advocate for student concerns.
- OIPS Immigration Session (Feb 18):
 - Open Q&A with an immigration attorney (details to be announced in the OIPS newsletter).
- How to Increase Student Engagement:
 - Need more structured discussions on advocacy and policy.
 - Consider hosting more forums to engage students on pressing issues.

Potential GAPSA Actions:

- Create a Microsoft Teams channel for GA representatives and Executive Board members
- Create a running list of resources regarding current domestic and international affairs
- Invite student life offices to speak during our upcoming GA meetings (i.e., LGBTQ+ Resource Center, QT BIPOC Initiative, Office of Disability Services)
