Doctoral Hooding Discussion

Background:

- **Past Years:** Hooding ceremonies occurred during the university-wide ceremony, limited to 2 hours.
- **Spring 2024:** GAPSA learned that hooding had moved off-stage, raising concerns.
- GAPSA Advocacy:
 - o Open letter sent to President Washington and senior administrators (May 6, 2024)
 - Administration response: Time constraints necessitate the off-stage format.
 Hooding will remain off-stage for this year

Concerns Raised:

- Doctoral students should receive proper recognition after years of study.
- Faculty and advisors may support a more formal hooding ceremony.
- Could undergraduate and graduate students have separate graduation ceremonies?
- Could hooding happen at college/school ceremonies?
- Next Steps:
 - o Carolyn will create a form to gather GA members' input on sending another letter to the administration.
 - o Possibility of drafting a resolution for stronger advocacy.

- Can graduating students vote? Yes, current part-time and full-time graduate degree seeking students can vote.
- Work Commitments for Officers:

 - Other officers: 5 hours/week on average (scholarship-funded)
